At Callowell, we recognise the importance of learning to read and have implemented the Little Wandle programme for phonics and reading. To support your child with their reading, we will ask you to complete weekly reading homework with them. This will commence once the children have completed the first part of the phonics programme and I will keep you informed of when this will start.

At Callowell we strive for 100% attendance. Here are some tips to help you keep your attendance up:

- Be on time. Lateness is recorded as a half day absence.
- Where possible, book non-emergency appointments out of school hours.
- If your child is unwell, inform the office and/or your child's class teacher immediately. This helps us to record the reason for the absence rather than it being recorded as unauthorised.
