EYFS Literacy Framework:	Coverage
Baseline (Development Matters 3&4 year olds):	
Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.	Writing sessions
Use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing. For example: writing a pretend shopping list that starts at the top of the page; writing 'm' for mummy.	
Write some or all of their name.	
Write some letters accurately.	
Progression towards the Early Learning Goal (Development Matters Reception):	
Form lower-case and capital letters correctly.	Writing sessions
Spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letter/s.	
Write short sentences with words with known sound-letter correspondences using a capital letter and full stop.	
Re-read what they have written to check that it makes sense.	
Early Learning Goal, Writing:	
Write recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed.	Writing sessions
Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sounds with a letter or letters.	
Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.
